GOD'S CHILDREN GREAT TALENT (GGCT)

GENERAL PRIVACY POLICY

Last updated: March 9, 2017

1. Introduction

God's Children Great Talent ("We") operates www.gcgt.org/ (the "Site"). We are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy therefore this page informs you of our policy regarding the collection, use and disclosure of Personal Information which we receive from users of the Site.

This policy applies to all "users," including those who have registered with us to create a profile, participate in the competition and/or upload a video.

This policy describes the collection of users' personal data and sets out the basis for which such personal data will be processed by us where that information is not otherwise publicly available. (For example: information that identifies a specific person, such as full name or email address)

By using the Site, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy.

2. Information Collection and Use

While using our Site, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you. Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to your name ("Personal Information").

- a) Registration Information is the information you submit to register for a Service, for example, to create a GCGT account, post comments on GCGT channels, receive a newsletter, or enter the GCGT talent show. Registration Information may include, for example, name, email address, gender, and birthday.
- b) Public Information and Posts consist of comments or content that you post to the Services and the information about you that accompanies those posts or content, which may include a name, user name, comments, likes, status, profile information and picture.
- c) Information from Social Media. If you access or log-in to a Service through a social media or connect a Service to a social media, the information collected may also include your user ID and/or user name associated with that social media service, any information or content you have permitted the social media service to share with us, such as

your profile picture, email address or friends lists, and any information you have made public in connection with that social media service. When you access the Services through social media services or when you connect a Service to social media services, you are authorizing GCGT and its third party contractors and/or affiliates to collect, store, and use such information and content in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

3. How we treat your personal data

Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it.

We may collect and process the following data about you:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our site [www.gcgt.org]. This includes Registration Information provided during the talent show, uploading videos and other information. We may also ask you for information when you enter a promotion sponsored by God's Children Great Talent, and when you report a problem with our site.
- If you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence.
- We may also ask you to complete surveys that we use for research purposes, although you do not have to respond to them.
- Details of your visits to our site and the resources that you access. For example, in order to permit your connection to the Services, our servers receive and record information about your computer, device, and browser, including potentially your IP address, browser type, and other software or hardware information. If you access the Services from a mobile or other device, GCGT Trust may collect a unique device identifier assigned to that device, geolocation data, or other transactional information for that device.
- Pictures uploaded with your application form.

4. IP addresses

We may collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration and to report aggregate information to our advertisers. This is statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns, and does not identify any individual.

5. Cookies

Cookies and other tracking technologies (such as browser cookies, pixels, beacons, and Adobe Flash technology including cookies) are comprised of small bits of data that often include a de-identified or anonymous unique identifier. Websites, apps and other services send this data to your

browser when you first request a web page and then store the data on your computer so the website, app or other service can access information when you make subsequent requests for pages from that service.

These technologies may also be used to collect and store information about your usage of the Services, such as pages you have visited, content you have viewed, search queries you have run and advertisements you have seen. Our Site uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our Site. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our Site and also allows us to improve our Site.

Third parties that support the Services by serving advertisements or providing services, such as allowing you to share content or tracking aggregate Services usage statistics, may also use these technologies to collect similar information. GCGT do not control these third-party technologies and their use is governed by the privacy policies of third parties using such technologies. Most browsers are initially set to accept cookies, but you can change your settings to notify you when a cookie is being set or updated, or to block cookies altogether. Please consult the "Help" section of your browser for more information. Please note that by blocking any or all cookies you may not have access to certain features, content or personalization available through the Services.

6. Where we store your personal data

The data that we collect from you may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside Nigeria. It may also be processed by staff operating outside Nigeria who works for us or for one of our suppliers. Such staff maybe engaged in, among other things, the fulfillment of your order, the processing of your payment details and the provision of support services. By submitting your personal data, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information through the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorized access.

7. Uses of the information

We use information held about you in the following ways:

- To ensure that content from our site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer.
- To provide you with information, products or services that you request from us or which we feel may interest you, where you have consented to be contacted for such purposes.
- To carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us.
- To allow you to participate in interactive features of our service, when you choose to do so.
- To notify you about changes to our service.

We do not disclose information about identifiable individuals to our advertisers, but we may provide them with aggregate information about our users (for example, we may inform them that 500 men aged under 30 have clicked on their advertisement on any given day). We may also use such aggregate information to help advertisers reach the kind of audience they want to target (for example, women in Lekki). We may make use of the personal data we have collected from you to enable us to comply with our advertisers' wishes by displaying their advertisement to that target audience.

8. Disclosure of your information

We may disclose your personal information to any member of our group, which means our subsidiaries and/or affiliates.

We may disclose your personal information to third parties:

- In the event that we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we
 may need to disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or
 buyer of such business or assets.
- If God's Children Great Talent or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by it about its customers will be one of the transferred assets.
- If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our terms of use and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of God's Children Great Talent, our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

9. Your Rights

Our Site may, from time to time, contain links to and from the websites of our partner networks, advertisers and affiliates. If you follow a link to any of these websites, please note that these websites have their own privacy policies and that we do not accept any responsibility or liability for these

policies. Please check these policies before you submit any personal data to these websites.

10. Updates to Privacy Policy

GCGT reserves the right to modify or update this Privacy Policy at any time and you should check this Privacy Policy periodically. Please look at the Effective Date at the top of this Privacy Policy to see when this Privacy Policy was last revised. Any changes to this Privacy Policy will become effective when GCGT Trust posts the revised Privacy Policy on the Services.

11. Other Important Information

a) Data Retention

GCGT will retain your information for the period necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy unless a longer retention period is required or allowed by law.

Remember that even after you cancel your account, copies of some information from your account may remain viewable in some circumstances where, for example, you have shared information with social media or other services. Because of the nature of caching technology, your account may not be instantly inaccessible to others. GCGT Trust may also retain backup information related to your account on our servers for some time after cancellation for fraud detection or to comply with applicable law or our internal security policies. It is not always possible to completely remove or delete all of your information due to technical constraints, contractual, financial or legal requirements.

b) Sensitive Information

GCGT Trust ask that you not send us, and you not disclose, any sensitive personal information (such as ATM and PIN numbers, information related to racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religion or other beliefs, health, criminal background or trade union membership) on or through the Services or otherwise.

12. Security

The security of your Personal Information is important to us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.
